This year marks the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Relay For Life and the Relay For Life of Kingman is ready to celebrate, remember and fight back.

What is Relay For Life? It is the American Cancer Society's signature activity that happens around the world. It brings a community together for a life changing event. Teams of friends and family camp out at White Cliffs Middle School as they have for the past 5 years and walk or run (their choice) the track for 12 hours. Does this mean that you have to be walking the whole 12 hours? No, as long as one person from each team is on the track... all is good.

Why do we say that Relay is a life changing event? Because, where some of the money raised stays here in Northern Arizona, the American Cancer Society sponsors many different research projects, 5 of which are in Arizona and are currently being funded. But again, why is Relay life changing for someone not touched by cancer? Because it celebrates life! Specifically it 'Celebrates' those who have battled cancer. It also 'Remembers' loved ones lost to the disease. Relay also is known for it's 'Fight Back' attitude because we are all there to put an end to cancer.

So, what can you do? Attend Relay For Life in Kingman, June 6/7 at White Cliffs Middle School. Enjoy the 'Relay Band', opening ceremonies are at 6pm on Saturday. Take a walk and see what the different teams are doing, buy some of the bake sale items or other special items for sale. More important, Kingman has been selected to participate in the Cancer Prevention Study 3 (CPS-3). It is a once in a lifetime opportunity for people with NO personal history of cancer to help fight cancer. We will be looking for people between the ages of 30-65 to join this study. Look for the CPS-3 tent, it will only take about 30 minutes of your time. This study is very important. If this tent has a long line, be patient and think of the people you will be helping, all the people in purple shirts, all the survivors.
